Scope

Responsible for overall IT computer, server, network, power, IP phone, surveillance, and Office 365 daily trouble tickets.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Receive and triage IT trouble calls for the company.
- Windows PC trouble shooting and repairs.
- Work closely with System and Network Administrators for escalation of tier 1 issues
- Perform general computer and server administration duties including installation, maintenance, upgrades, and troubleshooting.
- Administer and configure Office 365, SharePoint, and Teams.
- Administer general security controls such as antivirus, endpoint encryption, and access control.
- Set up user accounts, permissions and passwords.
- Administer multifactor authentication and remote access.
- Monitor health of IT environment.
- Monitor Security Information and Event Management (SIEM).
- Interface with vendors to procure and maintain IS/IT devices.
- Document IS/IT processes.
- Provide on-call and weekend support when needed.
- Prepare users by designing and conducting training programs.
- Ability to work flexible hours and/or different shifts, if needed.
- Ability to work in a safe professional manner adhering to all regulatory requirements including OSHA, EPA, State and Federal Regulations.
- As the Company's success relies on the productivity of our team and adherence to customer
 product schedules, an essential function of this position is the ability to arrive to work on-time, and
 work each day, as scheduled.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

Qualification Requirements:

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. - Ability to function successfully in both team and independent work environments.
- Update job knowledge by participating in educational opportunities, reading professional publications, maintaining personal networks, and participating in professional organizations.
